Tinnitus Support Group Leader - Telford

Role description

For this role you should either have experience of tinnitus yourself or have significant interest and knowledge in this area. Training on how to lead tinnitus support groups will be provided, along with any necessary equipment.

- Are happy to attend an informal online video call or phone call after applying for this role
